Our biggest need for the school is to complete our building. We currently have our second grade class meeting in a room that is about 10' by 12'. We have fifteen in that class plus the teacher and his desk. We have no place for third grade for next year.

To complete our building we need help. We do not have finances to hire builders to complete the work and need money to get it to lock up stage.

WHAT A MONTH!

Some months defy all resemblance of normality. March has been that kind of month. It started Friday morning March 1st with an emergency phone call from Steve telling me he had severed part of his middle finger on the table saw and please hurry. A dash in a borrowed truck, emergency treatment and hospital and much prayer the finger is now healing.

Sunday the 3rd our government declared a State of Emergency due to civil unrest including three murders several homes burned and looted. 150 arrested and 140 in protective custody.

We held our work day on the first dry day in weeks and Jim and Ari were severely burned and need medical attention. More prayer and they are healing nicely.

With rain, rain, and more rain and injuries to our workforce our building is moving slowly.

Sunday the 18th three followed the Lord in baptism. You never know what a month will bring.

We have two very pressing needs for the ministry in Vanuatu. **Need 1: Our major need is for skilled workers** to get our building to lock up stage where it can be used.

Need 2: Hymnals. We have red "The Hymnal".
